Grand Opening at Sward-Kemp

Sward-Kemp Drug company of Redwood Falls will observe grand opening of its remodeled and expanded store Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The store was doubled in size earlier this year when the firm took over the building formerly occupied by Melges Shore store.

There will be drawings for a color television set, transistor radio and other prizes, according to G.N. Nelson, man-

aging partner with G.E. Sward of Springfield and John H. Nelson.

The remodeled store features new fixtures, carpeting and lighting, and an enlarged prescription department. There are four pharmacists on the staff and a fifth—Earl McNae of Fairmont—is to be added soon.

The elder Nelson came to Redwood Falls in 1925 as manager of the store

after graduating from the University of Minnesota and working in Minneapolis and Worthington. He purchased an interest in the store in 1926 and again in 1930.

His son joined the firm in 1956 after graduation from University of Colorado at Boulder. He is a director of First Northwestern National bank, which is also holding grand opening of its new quarters.
